FIRST CALL FOR PAPERS

Presentation

The *International Seminar on Discourse and Argumentation Studies* (SEDiAr) assembles every two years researchers interested in the study of discourse and argumentation, in order to reflect upon the interface between these two fields from multiple theoretical-methodological perspectives. After the previous editions, which took place in 2012 at State University of Santa Cruz (UESC/Ilhéus, Brazil), in 2014 at Federal University of Minas Gerais (UFMG/Belo Horizonte, Brazil), in 2016 at Federal University of Sergipe (UFS/São Cristóvão, Brazil) and in 2018 at University of Buenos Aires (UBA/Buenos Aires, Argentina), SEDiAr's 5th edition will be held from August 4th to 7th 2020 at the Institute of Language Studies (IEL) of the State University of Campinas (UNICAMP), in Campinas, Brazil, jointly with the *III Semantics and Enunciation International Journey* (JISE), which congregates analysts of meaning, in order to reflect upon enunciation and other semantic issues. The historical relation between studies on argumentation, semantics and enunciation shall promote a productive debate in this joint event.

Modalities of participation

- 1) **Thematic Symposia (TS):** space for presentation and discussion of works within previously defined common themes.
- 2) **Individual Presentations (IP):** space for presentation of approved proposals, but not attributed to any symposium.

Abstract submission

The submission of proposals will happen in two moments:

- **MOMENT 1:** Proposals for coordinating a Thematic Symposium must be submitted until **September 10th 2019**. The results of approved abstracts for TS will be released by October 10th 2019.
- **MOMENT 2:** Proposals for presenting in a Thematic Symposium must be submitted from October 11th 2019 to November 30th 2019. The acceptance letters for presentation either in Thematic Symposia or Individual Presentations will be forwarded by February 10th 2020.

1st MOMENT

Submission of proposals for coordinating a Thematic Symposium (TS)

- Each Thematic Symposium must be coordinated by **2 PhDs**, who will submit an abstract to be evaluated by the Scientific Commission of V SEDIAR and III JISE.
- Once approved, each Thematic Symposium will be able to receive up to 8 (one session) or 16 (two sessions) presentations.

Abstract submission guidelines

- Submission deadline: **September 10th 2019**
- Abstracts must be submitted via an online platform, available on the following website: **<http://ics.iel.unicamp.br/>**
- For the abstract submission, both authors must be registered on the platform; however only the first author must submit the abstract, along with indicating the co-author's registered e-mail.
- Only one abstract submission by author and/or co-author is allowed.
- General theme: in order to be accepted, the proposals may be interdisciplinary, but they must be related to meaning and enunciation or discourse and argumentation issues.
- It is possible to propose discussions over theoretical aspects, concepts, methodologies, *corpora* analysis, history of ideas, amongst other possibilities.
- Abstracts can be either in Portuguese, Spanish, French or English. Exceptional cases will be assessed by the General Coordination of V SEDIAR and III JISE.

Abstract format:

- Thematic Symposium title: capitalized, bold type Times New Roman size 12 in centered alignment.
- Coordinators' names and institution affiliations: right alignment, Times New Roman size 12.
- Abstract of 350-400 words, single-paragraphed, single-spaced in Times New Roman size 12 in justified alignment. It must contain: (a) concise presentation of the problem or question to be addressed; (b) justifications; (c) objectives; (d) description of the adopted or expected theoretical-methodological perspective for the interventions.
- After the end of the abstract, four key-words with initial capital letters in Times News Roman size 12, separated by a full stop.

The role of Thematic Symposia coordinators

- Once the Thematic Symposium is approved, the coordinators commit themselves to cooperate with the event organization by selecting the presentations which will belong to their TS, as well as by organizing their order of presentation.
- The coordinators are considered collaborators of the event; for this reason, they are exempt from the registration fee.
- The coordinators can also propose a presentation in their TS.

2nd MOMENT

Submission of abstracts for presentation in Thematic Symposia

Abstract submission guidelines

- Submission period: **from October 11th 2019 to November 30th 2019**
 - Graduate students and degree holders (BA, BSc, MA, MSc, PhD) can submit an abstract for presenting in a TS.
 - Only one abstract submission by author and/or co-author is allowed.
 - Only one co-author is allowed.
 - Abstracts can be either in Portuguese, Spanish, French or English.
 - The approved proposals, but not attributed to the Thematic Symposium to which it applied, will be directed to the modality of individual presentations.
 - The orientations for formatting and submitting abstracts will be informed along with the approved Thematic Symposia release.

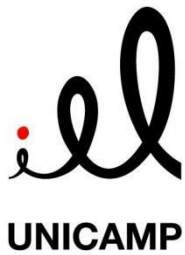
